HOW CAN CARD HELP?

CARD offers an array of services and programs for people with autism and related disabilities of all ages that are available for the entire family and the professionals that work with them throughout our region...all at no cost. These include consultations to schools, trainings, support groups, social groups for teens & adults, employment training programs, recreational camps & activities, and much more!

WHY SHOULD I BE PART OF CARD?

Once you are a client of CARD, you are a part of our family throughout your entire journey. You are also connected to the broader autism and related disability community throughout the State of Florida. Being part of CARD gives you critical access to a wealth of information and resources when you need them most.

WHO CAN BE PART OF CARD?

You can become a CARD client if you or a family member has a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) or a related disability including deaf-blindness, sensory impairments with other disabling conditions, and/or developmental delays in children under the age of 9 where autism is suspected. CARD serves families in Miami-Dade, Broward, and Monroe Counties, but there are other CARDS that serve the other 64 counties in Florida.

HOW CAN YOU BECOME A CARD CLIENT?

To become a client, simply scan the QR code on the right of this card, visit the link, or contact us via information on the front of this card. You can then choose to have an in person or virtual consultation with a CARD specialist who can help you access the resources you need for you or your loved one. The only thing you need to provide is documentation confirming the eligible diagnosis for you or your family member.
