For those who elect to receive services in-person, they are testing new patients for COVID-19 before their first session. They accept Medicaid, uninsured individuals, and private insurance. They have a 24-hour crisis mobile unit where they send a therapist to the home and assess the individual to see if they meet the requirements to be Baker-acted. If not, they will provide them with a referral to the outpatient clinic.

# Are you or someone you love going through crisis?



## **IF FACED WITH IMMINENT HARM TO SELF OR OTHERS, PLEASE DIAL 911.**

If the situation is life-threatening or if serious property damage is occurring, call 911 and ask for immediate assistance. When you call 911, tell them someone is experiencing a mental health crisis and explain the nature of the emergency, your relationship to the person in crisis, and whether there are weapons involved. Ask the 911 operator to send someone trained to work with people with mental illnesses such as a **Crisis Intervention Training officer (CIT)**, although they are not available in all areas.


